



The story of Sun Wine began over half a century ago when Zurab Mzekalashvili started growing Rkatsiteli grapes and producing Qvevri wines in the cellar at his home in Kvareli. His passion and love for viticulture and winemaking spread to the entire family and inspired three generations to continue in the family tradition of making unique wines of the highest quality, using some specific methods passed down from Zurab.

The winery and most of its vineyards are in Kvareli. This is a town located in the Alazani Valley, near the foothills of the Caucasus Mountains. The town is famous for its Kindzmarauli appellation.

Ilia Mzekalashvili is the head of the Sun Wine winemaking team. He brings forth 30 years' experience in winemaking and viticulture.

Description: Kindzmarauli is a wine appellation in the region of Kvareli in the northeast Kakheti Province of Georgia. This naturally semi-sweet Kindzmarauli is made with 100% Saperavi grapes harvested from vineyards located in the Alazani Valley near the foothills of the Greater Caucasus Mountains. Saperavi, which translates “to give color,” is the most dominant of Georgian red grapes. The fruit is thin-skinned and blueish-black in color, making a wine that is palatably upbeat and approachable with a slight sweetness and dominant notes of pomegranate.

Winemaker’s Notes: Made in the European method, using equipment and adjusting temperature to control the fermentation process.

Food Pairing Suggestion: Enjoy this semi-sweet Saperavi with fudge brownies, cheese and fruit.
