

The story of Sun Wine began over half a century ago when Zurab Mzekalashvili started growing Rkatsiteli grapes and producing Qvevri wines in the cellar at his home in Kvareli. His passion and love for viticulture and winemaking spread to the entire family and inspired three generations to continue in the family tradition of making unique wines of the highest quality, using some specific methods passed down from Zurab.

The winery and most of its vineyards are in Kvareli. This is a town located in the Alazani Valley, near the foothills of the Caucasus Mountains. The town is famous for its Kindzmarauli appellation.

Ilia Mzekalashvili is the head of the Sun Wine winemaking team. He brings forth 30 years' experience in winemaking and viticulture.

Description: Mukuzani, considered by many to be the best of the Georgian red wines, is made of Saperavi grapes. Saperavi is an acidic, teinturier-type grape whose red flesh and is due to anthocyanin pigments accumulating within the pulp of the grape berry itself. From the vineyards of Mukuzani, this Saperavi wine spent a year aging in an oak barrel. It's dark red hue and aromas of vanilla and rich berries are sure to intensify in palatable complexity with extended bottle aging.

Winemaker's Notes: Made in the European method, using equipment and adjusting temperature to control the fermentation process.

Food Pairing Suggestion: Any hearty vegetable dish, meat and cheese.
